The designer.

Ingmar Relling (1920–2002) was a key figure in the golden era of Scandinavian design. Simplicity, functionalism, elegance and uncompromising quality define his work. In 1965, Relling created the Siesta chair – his most celebrated design. Renowned for its exceptional comfort, lightness and modest size, Siesta quickly became a Norwegian design icon and remains so today.

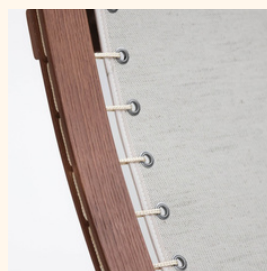


Technical info and materials.

Canvas is delivered in nature colour or black with a matching cord. Available in a wide range of fabrics and leather.



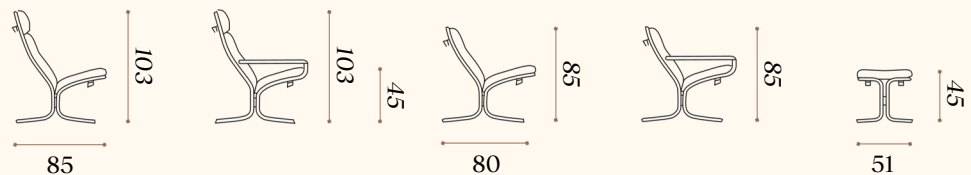

The original, featuring signature buttons.

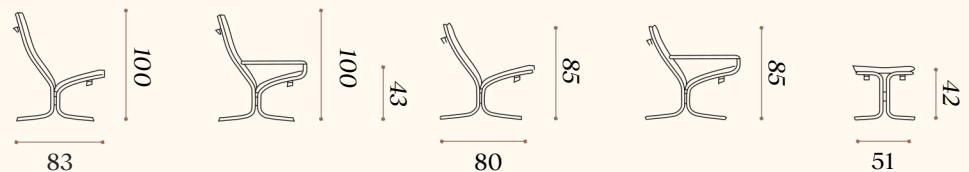
Available with high or low back, with or without armrests. Delivered with neck cushion in high version.

A minimalist and elegant expression.

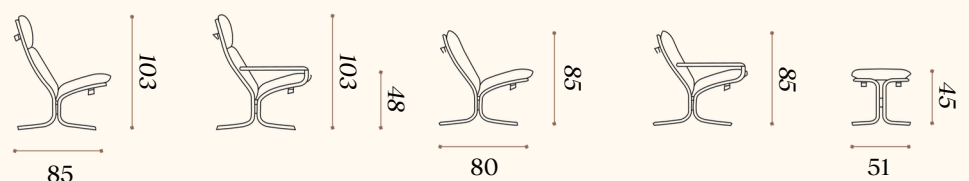
Available with high or low back, with or without armrests, with or without neck cushion.

Three separate cushions for a versatile, mix-and-match look.

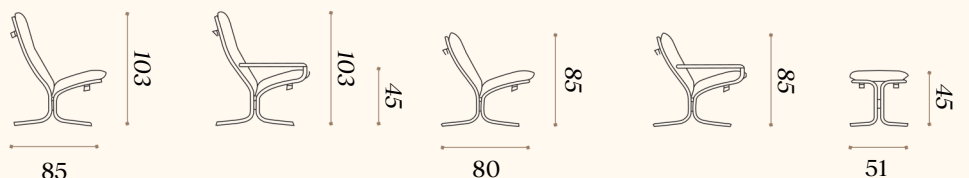
Available with high or low back. Available in a varied range of textiles and leathers. Armrests are only delivered in standard leather.
